# Special Focus Pilot Program in Agricultural and Environmental Sciences

### Wageningen University and Research Centre

This special-focus pilot program is available only to UC Davis College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences students.

*Wageningen University, a world leader in education and research in plant sciences, animal sciences, environmental sciences, agrotechnology, food technology, nutrition, and biodiversity, offers English-language course work to qualified undergraduate and graduate students. In addition to course offerings, students may benefit, in consultation with their departmental advisors, from extensive opportunities to undertake independent research projects and internships.*

*Dedicated to developing and disseminating the scientific knowledge needed to supply society's demand for sufficient healthy food while maintaining a healthy environment, Wageningen University has many research institutes and centers where ongoing research projects are conducted in agriculture and other scientific fields.*

#### DURATION

**Fall:** late July to late December

**Spring:** early January to late April, with optional summer term through early July

**Year:** late July to late April, with optional summer term through early July

#### ACADEMIC FOCUS

This special-focus pilot program is offered only to UC Davis College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences undergraduate and graduate students undertaking programs related to the following disciplines: Food Science, Biotechnology, Plant and Animal Sciences, Environmental Sciences, Agricultural and Biological Engineering, Nutrition, International Agriculture Development, Sustainable Agriculture and Agricultural Management. Students may also participate in credit-bearing internships and research projects which will be integrated into the regular semester course work.

Students attend classes with international students and host country students.

#### LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

English (courses also available in Dutch)

#### INTRODUCTORY LANGUAGE STUDY REQUIRED

A Dutch intensive language program (ILP) will be offered in August and January, prior to the fall and spring semesters, and is required for all students. During the semester, the study of Dutch language and culture is encouraged, but not required.

#### UNIT REQUIREMENTS

EAP students are required to take a full-time course of study abroad.

**ILP:** 3-6 UC quarter units

**Term:** 24 UC quarter units per semester

#### MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

**Class level:** Junior, Senior, Graduate

**GPA:** 3.0 cumulative GPA at the time of application and maintained through the end of the last term prior to departure. Students below a 3.0 must confer with a Campus EAP Adviser before submitting an application.

**Other:** Declared major in the College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences (CA&ES) at UC Davis. Undergraduate and Graduate students may be eligible to participate if they are enrolled in programs related to the following disciplines: Food Science, Biotechnology, Plant and Animal Sciences, Environmental Sciences, Agricultural and Biological Engineering, Nutrition, International Agriculture Development, Sustainable Agriculture and Agricultural Management.

#### SELECTION

Final selection is determined by consultation between the host university and the Campus EAP Office.

#### HOUSING

Students live in single or double rooms in student residence buildings with host country students, international students, and UC students. Student housing is located near the university.
